The Agenda and Notes from the July 3, 2019 meeting passed with unanimous consent.

2019 General Election:

Election Officer Training will be on Oct. 29, at 7:00 p.m. and Oct. 30, at 10:00 a.m.

Mr. Clements presented the ballot order estimate by precinct. The Board agreed with the estimates and the order will be sent to PrintElect. Sample ballots will be available on the Registrar's Web site prior to the election.

The voting machine for the Central Absentee Precinct will be certified on September 19 and the remaining machines on November 1, 2019.

High School Pages will help in many of the Precincts.

A Close of Registration Books Advertisement was submitted to the local paper.

Write-in Certification will begin November 6, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. Five teams of 2 Election Officers will be counting the write-in votes.

Mr. Clements attended the VRAV annual meeting in August, as well as the meeting with ELECT/DHS/NGA on Election Security Bill from the Legislature. The latter meeting was on Standards for Information Technology.

The Office is switching to Bulk Mail for Registration Notices from 1st Class mail, which the Board approved by unanimous consent.
