Minutes

The meeting was called to order 3:37 p.m.

Board members James Holmes, Tracy Neely, and Clive Richmond were all present, as was Director of Elections James Clements and Equipment Custodian Andrew Wynham and Culpeper County Democratic Committee (CCDC) and NAACP member Ed Dunphy.

The agenda was approved by unanimous consent, with the addition of a public comment period, as were the minutes from the Feb. 10, 2021 Meeting.

Old Business:

- I. M. Dunphy spoke to the Board as a member of the CCDC and the NAACP in support for Sunday voting before the November Election.
- II. June 8 Dem. Party Primary Updates
 - a. 10,000 ballots have been received and prepared for distribution for the election.
 - b. Two of the Carts used for transporting equipment, ballots and paperwork were repaired. The estimate developed by Mr. Clements is the remaining Carts can be repaired/upgraded for approximately \$4,500.
 - c. The Office will be open for in-person absentee voting on Saturdays May 29 and June 5.
 - d. All precinct will be open on election day.
 - e. The Serv-Pro cleaning in the precincts will be the same as for the March 30 Special Election.
 - f. Drop boxes will be used again in the Precincts.
 - g. Election Officer training will be sent to each Officer.
 - h. I Voted Stickers – Mr. Clements suggested and the Board approved of a new design contest for all Schools in the County. Mr. Clements will coordinate with public and private schools.
 - i. L&A testing is scheduled for May 26.

The next Board meeting is tentatively scheduled for May 5 at 10:00 a.m. *(Note: This meeting was later cancelled.)*
